

This book is a great point-by-point Catechism for those just beginning to learn about Christianity and Catholicism. While it starts a little simplistically for someone already familiar with the Church's teachings, it does give excellent explanations for those new to the faith. This would be a great gift for a child preparing for their first communion; along with the Catechism of the Catholic Church

(which this book is an explanation of) it might even serve well for teenagers in preparation for confirmation, especially if they are poorly catechized. This book is also a great start for introducing friends to the Church who are curious but unaware of what the Church believes.

This is an EXCELLENT book if you're new to Catholicism, are curious about it, or just want to refresh your knowledge and fully understand what being a Catholic is all about. It is a very easy read and the chapters are quite short; however, there is A LOT of information packed in this book. Highly recommend. Rating: 5 stars
