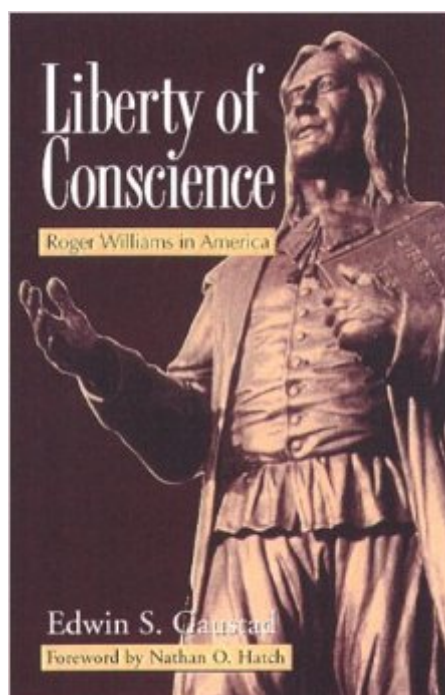


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# Liberty Of Conscience: Roger Williams In America

These religious and political leaders insisted that all land not actually occupied and cultivated belonged, not to the Indians, but to the Massachusetts Bay Colony, which they controlled. Roger Williams was tried and banished from Massachusetts in 1635 because he declared that 'the Natives are the true owners' of the land. His heretical views on the land question were condemned as no less dangerous than his unorthodox religious opinions."--George Novack in *Americas Revolutionary Heritage*. Among the present rantings against Islam, those who try to sound intelligent proclaim that unlike other religions, Islam has never accepted separation of church and state.
